



Take part opportunity



Research being carried out by the Department of Rheumatology and Clinical Immunology at the Amsterdam UMC, is exploring whether it might be possible to treat people who have psoriasis to reduce their risk of developing psoriatic arthritis. Understanding preferences is important to ensure future treatments of this kind are efficient and acceptable to those who have psoriasis.

They have produced a survey, which aims to understand what medications or lifestyle changes would be acceptable to people with psoriasis, to reduce their chances of developing psoriatic arthritis in the future. It is a one-time questionnaire that should not take longer than 20 minutes to complete online.

Participation is voluntary, and all responses to the survey will remain confidential and anonymous.

Take part criteria:

- Aged 18 years or older
- Have been diagnosed by a doctor as having psoriasis
- Currently living in the United Kingdom
- Are able to read and complete a survey that is in English
- Have not been diagnosed by a doctor as having psoriatic arthritis
